

1. How old are you?







4. What is bullying?




5. What is the most dangerous type of violence according to you?


6. Have you ever committed any acts of violence, small or serious?



8. How can school tackle violent acts? (more than 1 answer)




In the question whether the students have ever been the victim of a violent event **54,1%** answer negatively.

10. If you were a victim of a violent event, you ...





If they were a victim of a violent event **59,5%** answered that they would report it to a teacher or an adult, **22,5%** answered that they would take revenge on the perpetrator, **19,8%** would keep silent,**9,9%** would break out in whoever they find in front of them and **7,2%** would be afraid.





12. Would you be violent with someone if you were provoked?



13. Do you think that strong people are the ones that generally commit violent action against weaker ones?



14. What is the most common type of violence that occurs at your school?




15. Do you feel safe at your school?




48,6% answered that they feel safe at school, **36,9%** not always and only **14,4%** answered negatively.


38,7% believe that boys are more prone to violence, **9%** believe that girls are more prone to violence and **52,3%** believe that boys and girls are equally prone to violence.








51,4% believe that victims of violent events should report it to their families first, **45%** to their teachers and only **3,6%** to the police.



53,2% feel that peer pressure (treatment, fashion, reputation) leads to violence at schools, **33,3%** feel that parental negligence (abuse, neglect, divorce, conflicting relationships), **13,5%** feel that entertainment (videogames, movies, book, art).


20. Do you think violence can be prevented with a proper education at schools?



38,7% think that violence can be prevented with proper education at schools, **41,4%** maybe and **19,8%** answer negatively.


21. How can you manage your anger? ((more than 1 answer)
